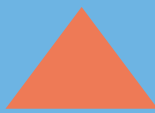

OHIO DENTIST LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM

\$877,900

This program was created in 2003 and is fully funded by Ohio dentists. It provides loan repayment for dentists who practice in designated shortage areas, treat Medicaid patients and provide care to patients regardless of their ability to pay. ODA developed the legislation to create this program. In 2014, the ODA successfully advocated for doubling the funding of this program.
