## SAMPLE TREATMENT PLAN

In 2015, OPTIONS patients often received the full range of dental services, including:

- exams
- cleanings
- x-rays
- partial dentures
- full dentures
- extractions
- fillings
- root canals
- treatment of gum disease
- crowns
- oral cancer screenings
- fluoride varnish

Dental OPTIONS is a program provided through a joint partnership between the ODA and the Ohio Department of Health that helps eligible, low-income uninsured adults in Ohio obtain access to dental care by linking them with volunteer dentists.
